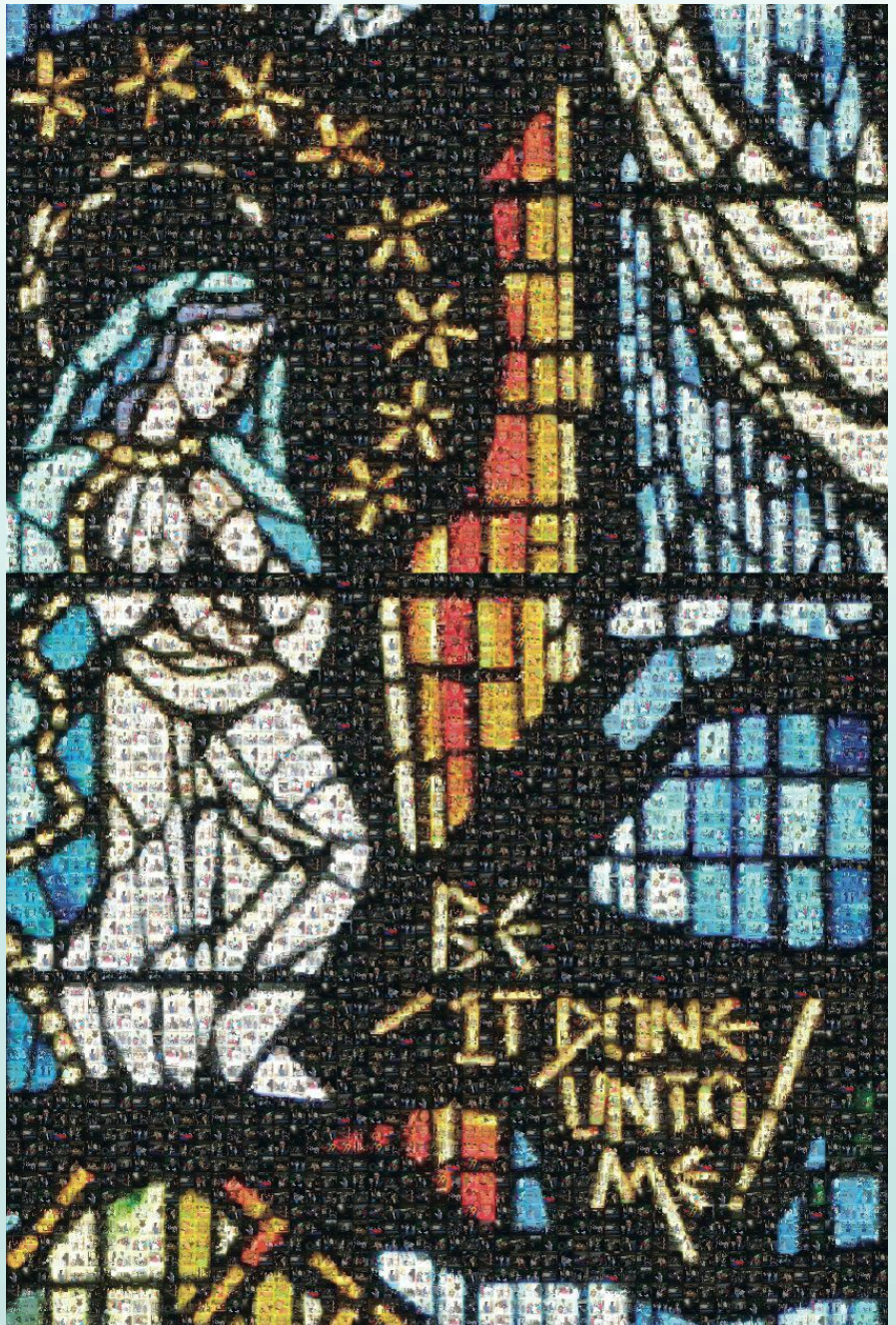

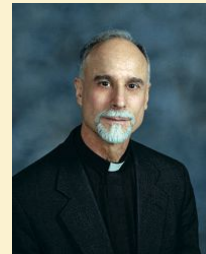

Pope Francis was Cardinal Jorge Bergoglio, Archbishop of Buenos Aires, when he told his flock in 2009:

“Not only do terrorism, repression and murder violate human rights, but also extreme poverty and the unjust economic structures that give rise to great inequalities violate these most basic rights. Social inequality is immoral, unjust and illegitimate when it occurs in a nation that has the objective conditions for avoiding or correcting such harm.

We all have the duty to work to change the structural causes and personal or corporate attitudes that give rise to this situation, and through dialogue reach agreements that allow us to transform this painful reality we refer to.

The issues of social justice must be of concern to every sector of society, including leaders in government, politics, finance, business, agriculture, industry, unions, the church and other social organizations”.

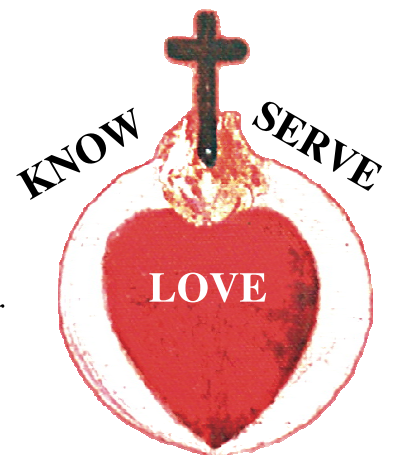

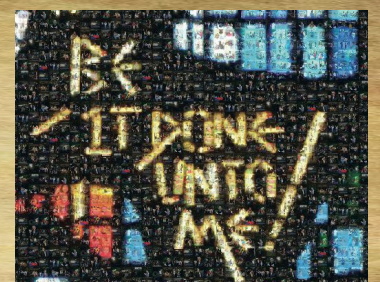

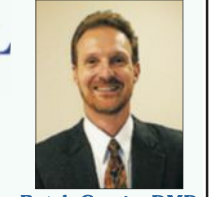
